Pericopsis Elata



Our Afrormosia is sourced from West Africa and is commonly used in for products such as flooring, veneers, and furniture. It has excellent durability and is resistant to insects. It can also be used as an economical appearance option for Burmese Teak. Afrormosia should not be used for marine exterior applications. Afrormosia heartwood is yellowish brown, occasionally with a reddish or olive-colored hue, darkening with age. Narrow sapwood is pale yellow and is clearly differentiated from the heartwood.

Yellowish Brown with an Occasional Reddish Tint.

Straight or Interlocked Grain, Medium Uniform Texture.
