
# ZEBRAWOOD

Microberlinia brazzavillensis





Our Zebrawood is sourced from West Africa and is commonly used in Millwork projects such as furniture, veneers, tool handles, and skis. Zebrawood is resistant to termites and other insects. Its heartwood is light brown to straw color with dark blackish brown streaks, vaguely resembling zebra stripes. Depending on whether the wood is flatsawn or quartersawn, the stripes can either be wide and erratic (flatsawn) or somewhat narrow and uniform (quartersawn).



### **Appearance & Grain**

Heartwood is a light brown or cream color with dark blackish brown streaks vaguely resembling a zebra's stripes. Depending on whether the wood is flatsawn or quartersawn, the stripes can be either chaotic and wavy (flatsawn), or somewhat uniform (quartersawn).



#### Fun Fact:

The dark black and brown streaks down the wood vaguely resembles zebra stripes, which is where Zebrawood got its name.
