Our Black Limba is imported from tropical areas of Africa. It has a vibrant color of light yellow to golden brown with grey and black streaks and veins. Black Limba is non-durable and susceptible to insect and termite attacks. It is very easy to work with both with hand and machine tools. It is most commonly used for veneer, plywood, furniture, musical instruments, and turned objects.
