*Panopsis spp.*



Our Lacewood is imported from more tropical areas of South America such as Brazil. This wood is reddish brown with grey or light brown rays which result in the lace pattern. Lacewood is non-durable and is susceptible to termite and insect attacks. It is overall easy to work with most commonly producing veneers, cabinetry, fine furniture, musical instruments, and turned objects.
